Toothpaste Hacks
Price, Peas and Pop it upside down!!!

Try swapping your branded toothpaste for a supermarket own one, which can be 7x cheaper. As long as it contains at least 1450ppm fluoride per ml (most fluoride everyone from babies, toddlers, teens and all the adults can use the same stuff - One size can fit all!)

Check how much paste you are using, you could be using 1/3 as much as you need to get. Everyone who uses spit out should be using a small pea sized amount. Only babies 0-3 yrs use a smear. Use less and make it last longer!

Simply turn your toothpaste upside down! Keep grinding on your sides so you can get the most out of your tube. Keep squeezing the paste down to the cap with a roller or handle of a spoon! You can push the cap use every last bit!
